Fire Destroys Westmeath Farm House

PEMBROKE (Staff)—Gordon Davidson, a Westmeath Township farmer, escaped injury when his home was destroyed in an early morning fire Friday.

The two-storey, frame house, five miles west of Westmeath on the Bromley Line, was completely destroyed. Cause of the fire has not been determined.

Mr. Davidson, a bachelor, lived alone.

The Westmeath fire brigade, under Chief Gerald Gervais, prevented the flames from spreading. Firemen were called back to the farm when wind rekindled the fire 12 hours after it was first reported.
