

MRS JOHN DAVIDSON

The death of a former resident of Westmeath Township, Mrs. John Davidson occurred on Wednesday January 20, 1980, in Miramichi Lodge, Pembroke, in her 87th year.

Born in Westmeath Township, she was formerly Pearl Ethel Dougherty, daughter of Robinson Dougherty and his wife, Margaret Jeffrey. She attended school in Lapasse.
