

KNOWN IN PEMBROKE.

The Pembroke Standard says: Isabel MacGregor, wife of Mr. Alexander Rodgers, engineer C. P. R., died at her home at Skead's Mills, near Ottawa. Mrs. Rodgers was for years a resident of Pembroke, having resided in the East ward with her husband and family. They removed to Skead's Mills, where they purchased a fine property. The deceased leaves a husband, three sons and two daughters. She was forty-nine years of age at the time of her death. Cancer was the cause of death. The remains were brought to Pembroke and interred in the family plot in the Presbyterian cemetery. Besides the members of her family, they were accompanied here by deceased's brother, Mr. MacGregor, a manufacturer of Western Ontario, and other relatives. It was at the home of the Rodgers that Mr. George Whitmore, of Perretton, died last fall, and the deceased lady nursed that greatly esteemed young man with all the kindness and care of a mother during his last illness.
