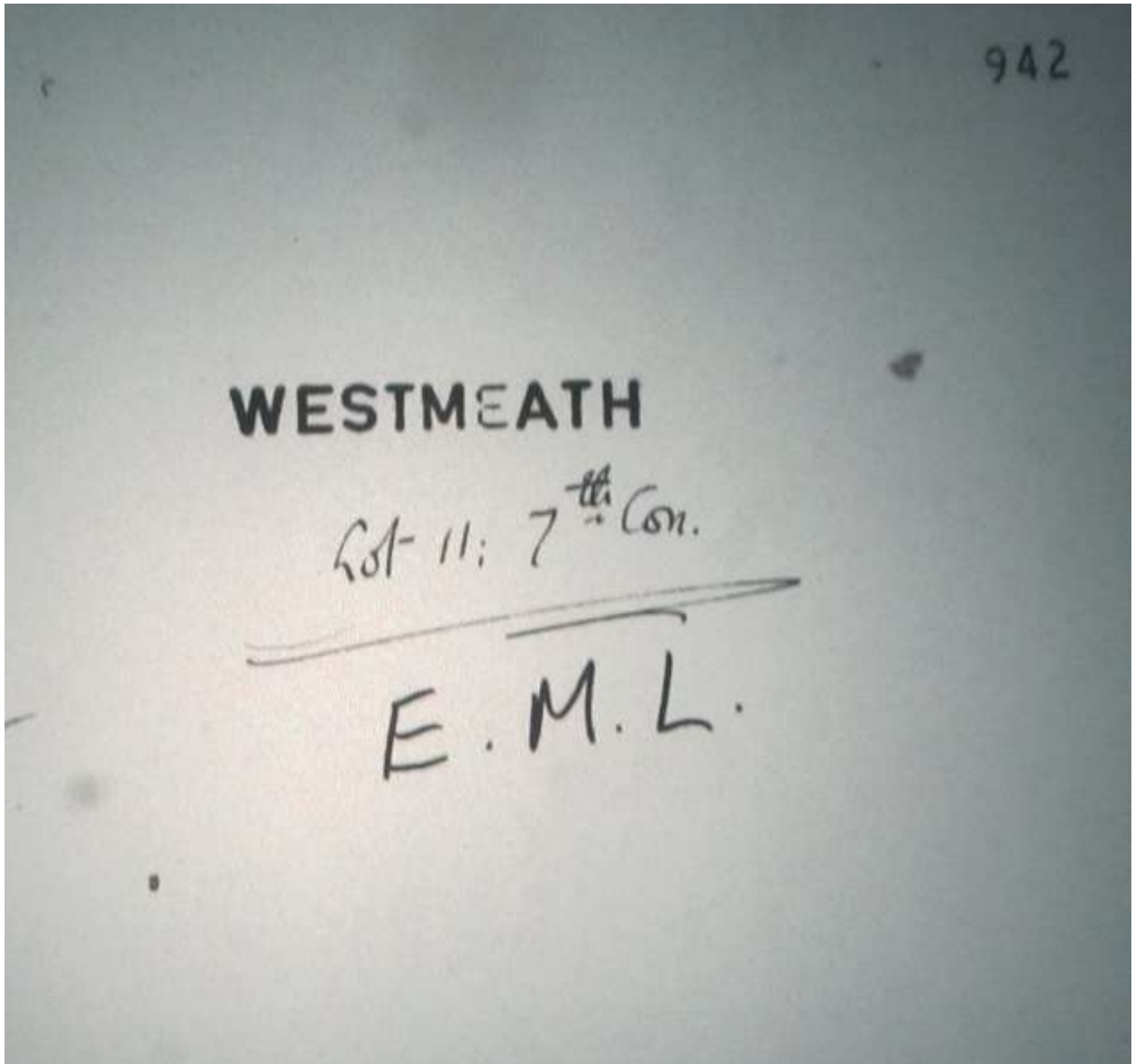

 gular that certain parcel or parcels  
 of ground and premises situate  
 lying and being in the townshub  
 of Westmeath in the county of Kildare  
 Province of Leinster a Moore as the  
 North half of the South half of lot  
 Number eleven to the Seventh Row  
 of the townshub of Westmeath  
 aforesaid containing five acres  
 more or less together with all  
 houses out houses woods and  
 water thereon erected lying

and being in the town he thereon.

I have yet to hold the same  
to the said John Mitchell to be
