That I am the party entitled to the grant from the Crown of the North Half of lot number twelve, in the sixth concession of the Township of Westmeath.

That the sale of the said land was made to me in trust to support my mother Jane Little during her lifetime and at her death to me absolutely.

That my said mother Jane Little died upwards of eight years ago -
