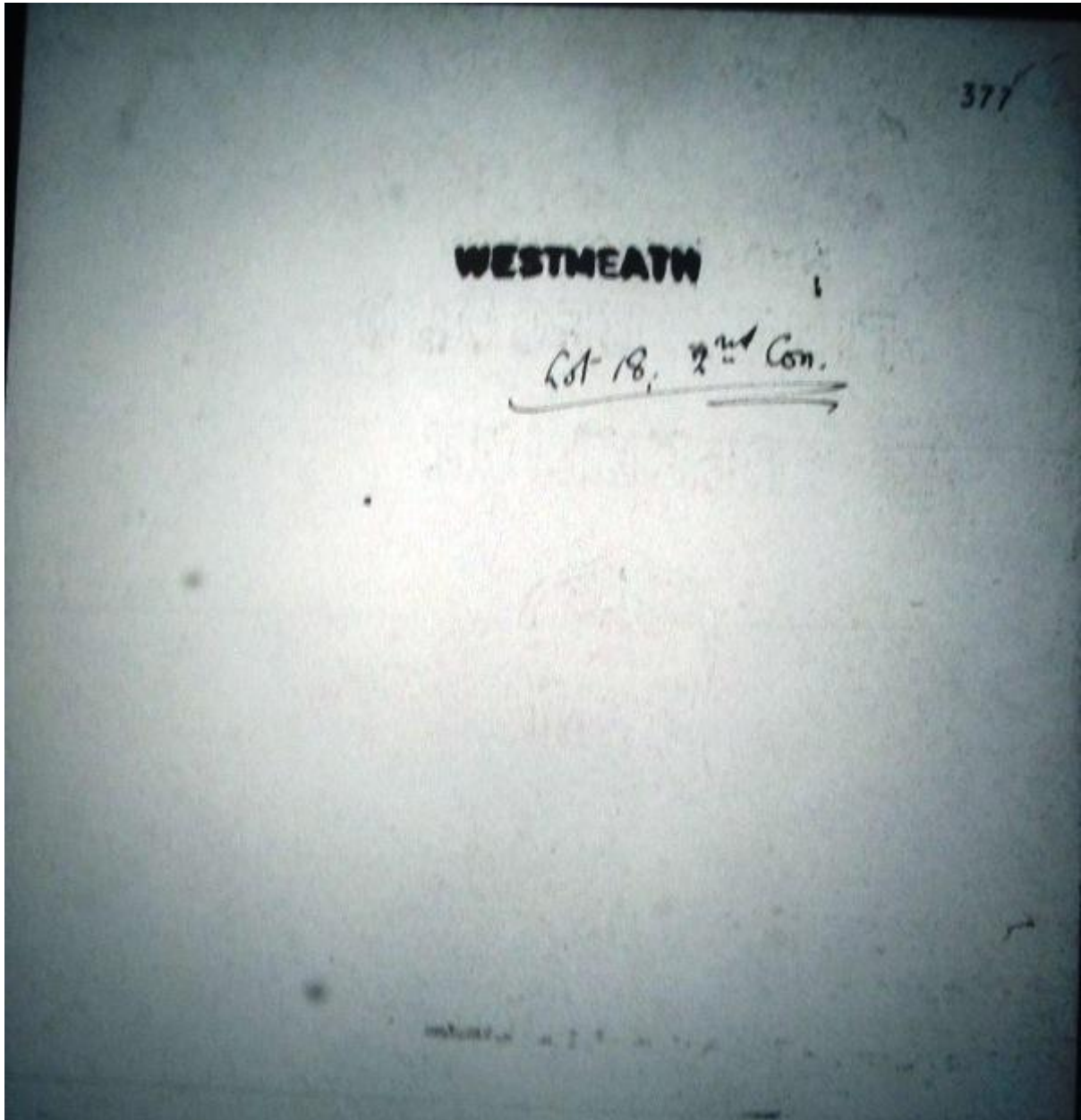

 October 1832," to Locate the claim of David
 Hunter for 200 Acres, in any of the Townships
 under my superintendance, was had by me, from
 John S. McDougall Esqr. at whose Request I lo-
 cated the said claim, upon Lot No. 13 of 200 acres
 in the 2nd Concession west of Muskrat Lake, in
 the Township of Westmeath, in the month of
 December 1833. (he the said John S. McDougall
 having previously purchased Lot No. 17/194 acres
 in the same concession) And that a Return of
 of the said Location was duly made by me to
 the Crown Lands Department.


