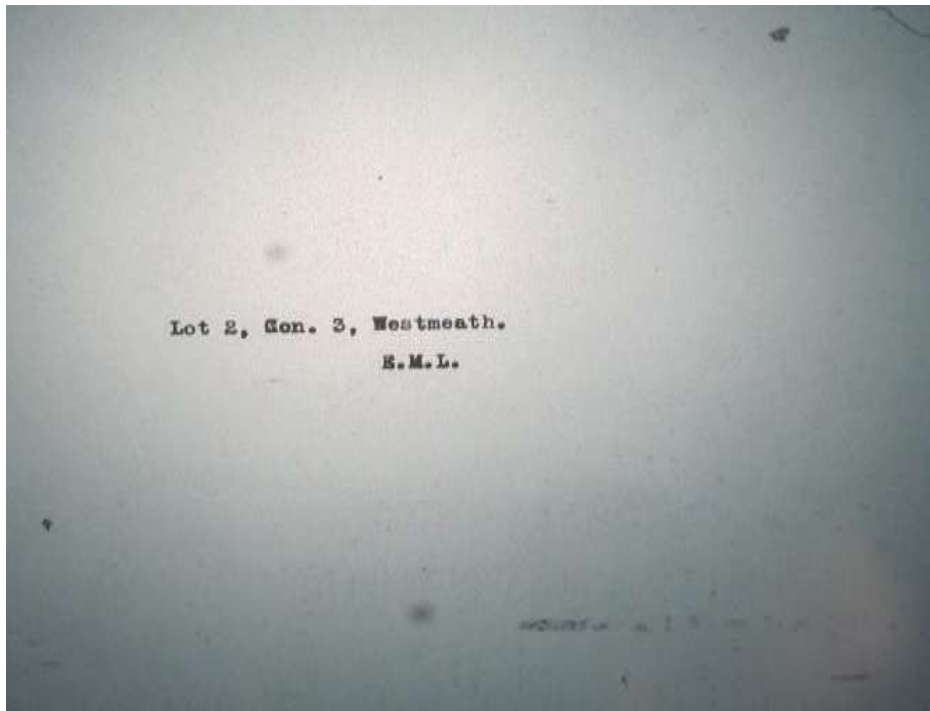

Agreement between James Colford  
 and Eldridge Howard  
 March 27<sup>th</sup> 1858

Whereas the two individuals above named  
 namely James Colford residing in the  
 Township of Mc. Sab and Eldridge  
 Howard in the Township of Westmeath  
 are both Applicants to the Crown for  
 Lot No 2 in the 3<sup>d</sup> Concession of West-  
 meath East of Muskrat Lake we  
 hereby by mutual consent agree to divide  
 the said Lot between us as follows  
 namely that the said James Colford be  
 allowed to purchase the North half of said  
 Lot and Eldridge Howard the South half  
 dividing the Lot lengthways. The said two  
 individuals having entered into this agreement  
 this Twentieth Day of March. Eighteen-  
 hundred and Fifty-eight.
