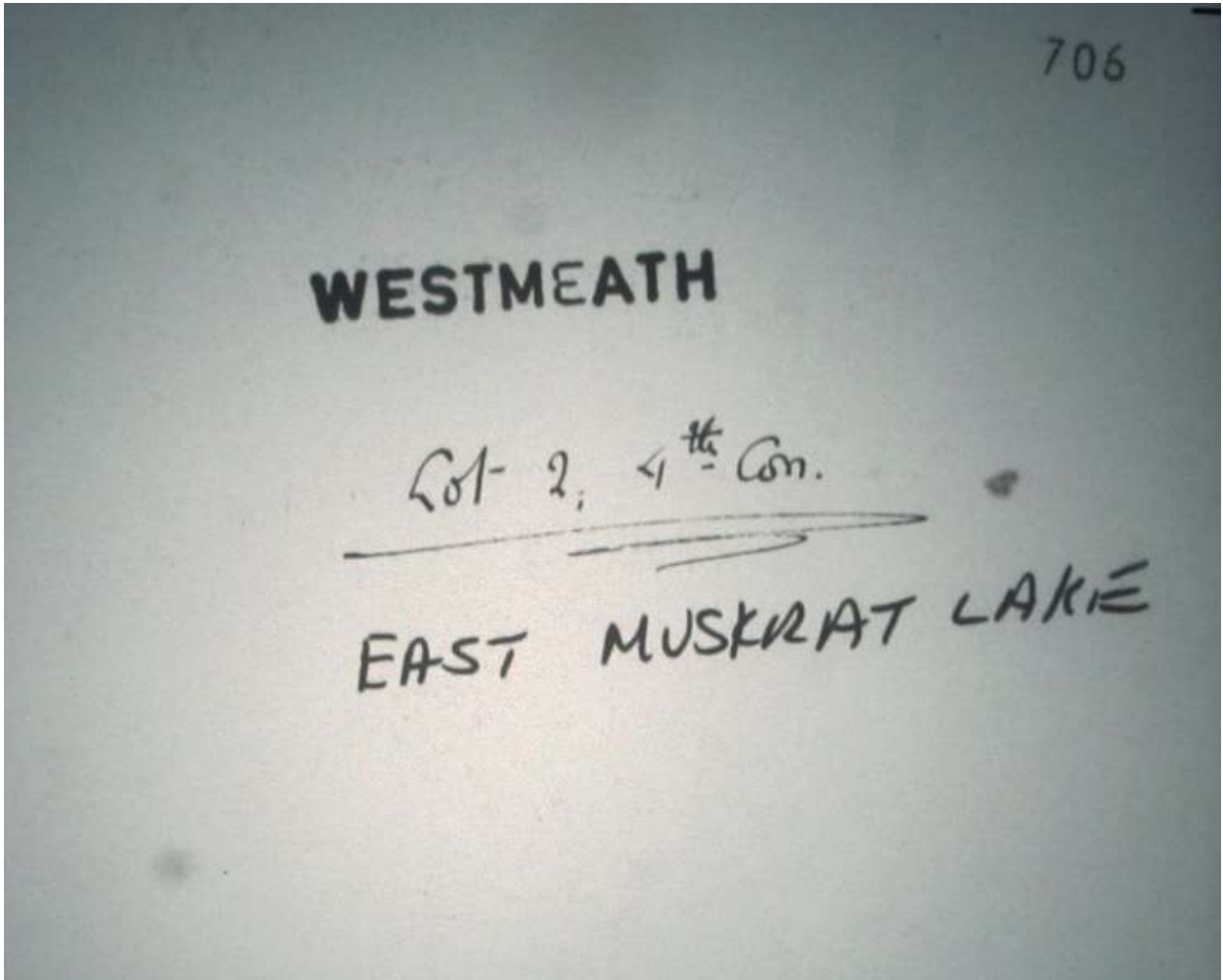

Herewith is sent the copy of a letter addressed to the Registrar of the County of Kenilworth which explains why the Department hesitates in issuing a Patent prepared for Mr. George Stockins who purchased lot N^o. 2 in the 5th Con. of Westmeath.

In reply to the letter Mr. Morris stated that Mr. Abraham Brach had exercised ownership over and conveyed to another the South 1/2 of lot N^o. 2 in the 4th Con. which had been granted

by Patent to him in May 1832

From which it might be
inferred that we had not exercised
control over the $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Lots either
on the 4th or 5th Concessions

Something more definite is
however required before any action can
be taken by the Department in the
matter.

You will therefore endeavor to
procure information which will set
the question at rest, either thro' the
Registrar of the County, or by the
production of the Patent issued on the
5th of November 1838 to Mr. Abraham

Sir,

The Patent for Mr. Geo. Hoskins, to which reference was had in writing to you on the 21st of January, is herewith sent for delivery.

Although there is reason to suppose that the N^o 2 of the lot is not covered by the Patent issued to Mr. Abrahams Beach (November 5th 1838); he having exercised ownership over the whole of N^o 2 in the 4th Con^o. It is very desirable that the two Patents granted to Mr. Beach (dated Nov^r 5th 1838, for the N^o 2, and May 23rd 1842, for the S^o 2) should be produced in order that the records of the Provincial Registrar's Office may be corrected, if as supposed an error has occurred, — they being probably in the possession of Mr. Barnabas Goodman, the assignee of Mr. Beach.

It would be well to explain the matter to Mr. Hoskins, for if the Patent (of November 1838) granted the N^o 2 of the lot in the 5th Con^o; instead of that in the 4th Con^o as intended, the deed to Mr. Hoskins would be void as regards
