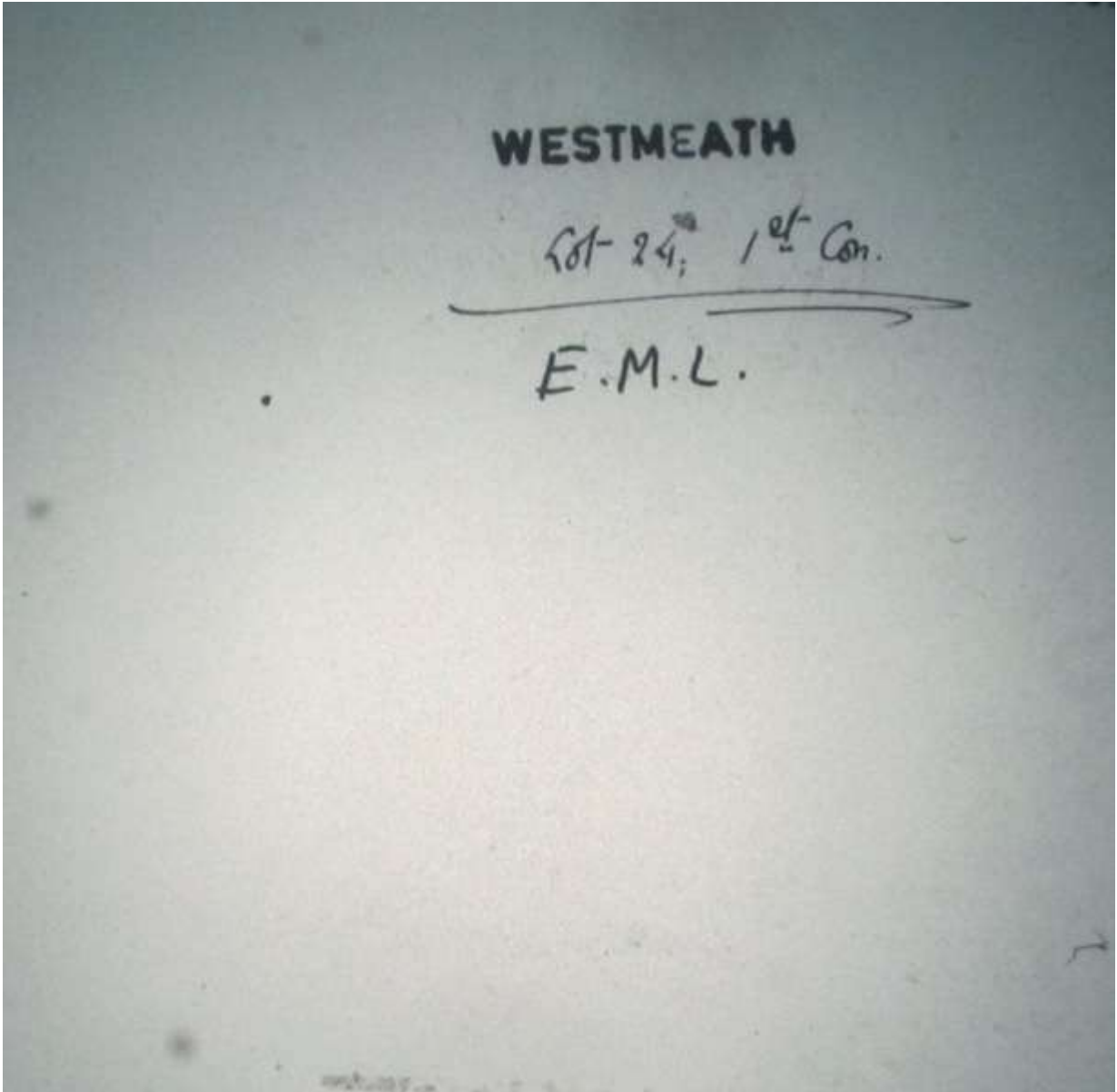

as a discharged Soldier from the
Hungary Light Infantry Fusiliers
in the Township of Westmeath
in the County of Louth

in the District of Bathurst being
The North part of Lot Number 24
in the first Concession that is to say,

Commencing in the Eastern limit of allowance for Road on the Western
boundary of the Township and at the North West Angle of
the said Lot

then North 5 1/4 degrees 25 minutes West 66 chains 64 Links
more or less, to the ~~limit between the first and second Concessions~~
then North 35 degrees 35 minutes East 10 chains 57 Links
more or less, to the ~~center of the road~~ between Lots No
then South 5 1/4 degrees 25 minutes East 55 chains 1 Link
more or less, to the ~~center of the road~~ then West along the Western
edge to the allowance for road on the Western boundary of the Township
then South 35 degrees 35 minutes West 10 chains 1 Link
more or less, to the place of beginning

containing 100 Acres more or less.
