Dear Sir,

I beg leave respectfully to represent to you, that in 1838 or 1839 I bought from the Hon. Malcolm Cameron, some claims for land, and among them Lots N<sup>o</sup> 8 and 10. in the 6th Concession of Westmeath in the County of Lanark District of Perthshire, and that in lieu of giving me a Transfer deed, he gave me Deeds from the parties having claims as U. E. Loyalists. viz Lot N<sup>o</sup> 8 from John Glow and Lot N<sup>o</sup> 10 from Henry D. Glow. These Deeds were passed on the 2<sup>d</sup> & 3<sup>d</sup> July 1839. and duly registered in the same month of the same Year.

I am now credibly informed that a person has lately been in Westmeath, and says that he has a Deed of Lot N<sup>o</sup> 8, and will be up in the Spring to sell it.

I desire to know if the Patents for these Lots were issued previous to the above mentioned date 3 July 1839, and if not, whom and to whom were they issued, or such other information, as you may deem necessary in the premises, and your early attention to this request will greatly oblige
