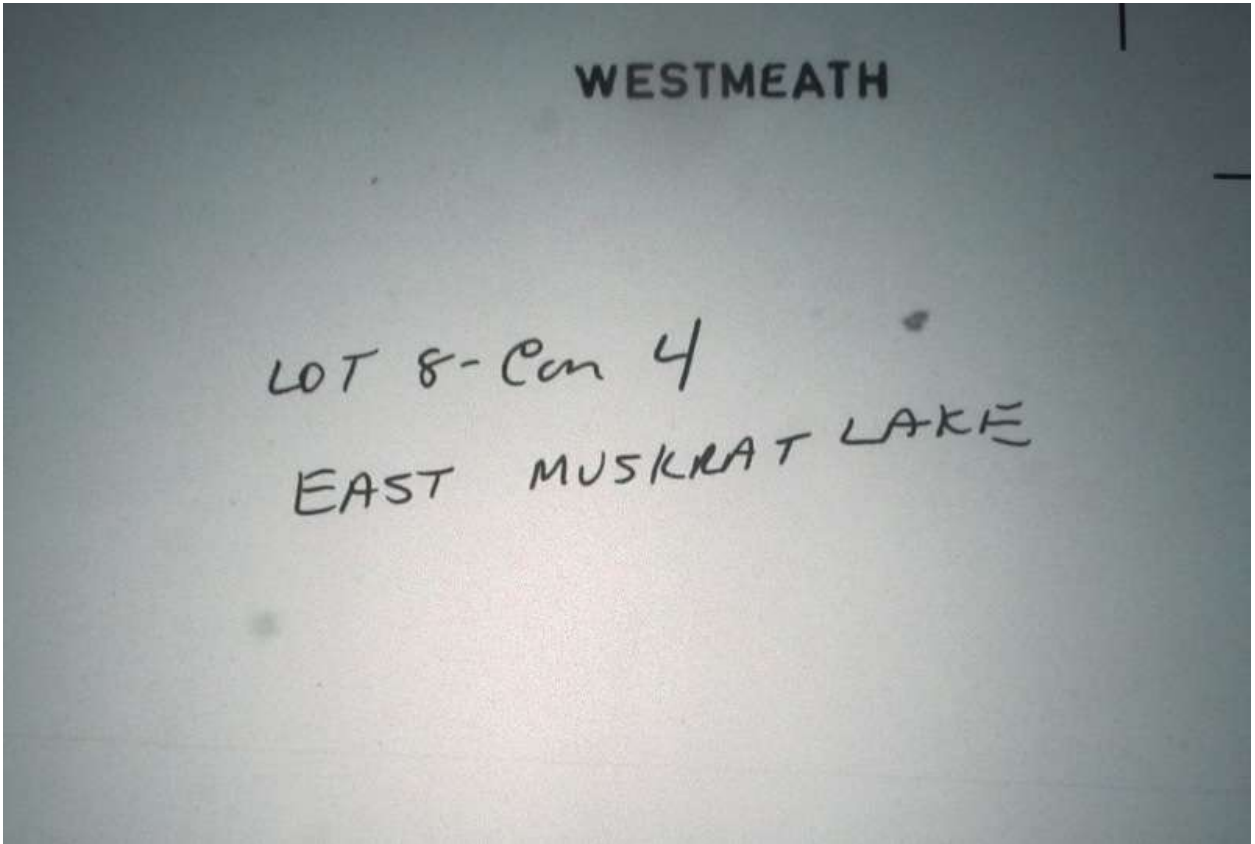

Sir

In pursuance to the request of Mr. James Davison, I have the honor to submit for your consideration the report of inspection and valuation of Lot No. 4 in the Third Commission of the Township of Westmount, a Copy Reserve

about 37 acres on the front of the west 1/2 of this lot, a Bone Meadow, and a fringe of unimprovable rocky hills, and 12 acres on the East 1/2 situate in two ponds 12 deep abrupt depressions. The subsoil is Clay but generally overlaid with too great a depth of sand, differing in color and quality according to relative position, the finer and lighter colored occupying the higher levels; consequently the quality of the land varies with the inequalities of the surface, from a fine yellowish sand, to a brown colored gravelly soil, with a very light covering of vegetable mould, supporting a medium sized growth of Birch, Maple, Birch and (now) white Pine. The present value does not exceed Bone Milling for 2012

4) - A person named McCormick made a clearing of 42.5 acres on the East 1/2 about 5 1/2 years ago, but abandoned it the following year, it is now grown over with brushwood and cannot be reasonably considered of any additional value, from the information I collected relative thereto, from persons residing in that neighborhood, Mr. McCormick had left Canada
