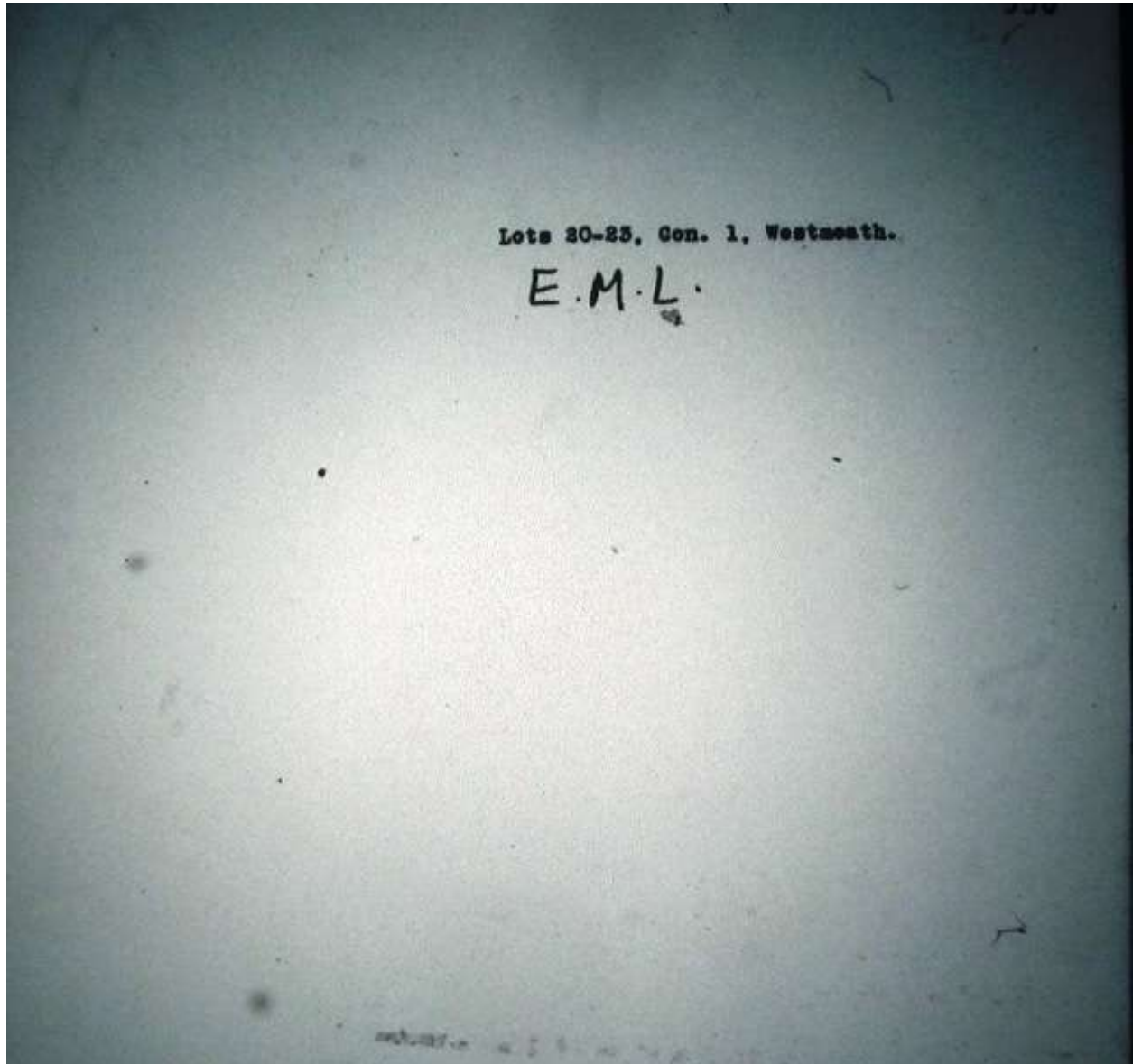

Upper Canada 21st August 1835.

Sir, Having fixed upon Lots Number Twenty, Twenty
Twenty two, & Twenty three: of one hundred
Acres each viz: Four hundred Acres of land
in the First Concession of the Township of
Westmeath in the Bathurst District. & as the
Agent for the District Mr. MacNaughton has
directed immediate possession may be taken
thereof. I have to request you will be pleased
to submit the matter to the Governor in Council
that I may obtain their sanction also as I
am about to ~~set~~ work upon the land.

I shall transmit the remaining of Two hundred
Pounds Provincial Currency to Toronto, or to the
Agent at Bytown as you may direct, after effecting
a suitable clearance and erecting a dwelling house.

Or I shall attend a sale at Bytown when announced
should you still deem such form necessary. It must
be near the middle of September ere Mr. MacNaughton can have
reached Toronto as he still continues the survey in Westmeath, which
will render the sale late in the season.

District, 16th March 1896.

Sir,

Two days since I sent a special
messenger to Bytown on Land business.

First Concession Westmeath, which
he can discover by consulting his map
of survey. I have also to request you
will be pleased to acquaint me with
the probable time of sale, that I may
be enabled to commence upon the
land early in the summer.
