

Violet Montgomery Obituary

The death of Miss Violet Mary Ann Montgomery occurred on Friday, June 14, 1963 in the Pembroke Cottage Hospital.

Born 62 years ago in Alice Township she was the youngest daughter of the late Nelson Montgomery and his wife formerly Lucy Johnstone. Receiving her early education there she attended the Pembroke Collegiate Institute and the North Bay Normal School. Following graduation she was a music teacher two years in Tweed, three years Grant's Ridge and 35 years in Lower Greenwood S.S. # 9, Westmeath. She had held offices in the County Women's Teachers' Federation and also the Westmeath-Beachburg unit WFT; was a supporter of the Beachburg Standard Church, a charter member of the Ottawa Valley Historical Society and vice-president when it was organized in 1955.

Surviving is one brother Strothers Montgomery and one sister Miss Ethel Montgomery, RR #2 Foresters Falls. Two sisters, Misses Susan and Ella Montgomery died several years ago.

Funeral services were held on Monday at her home in Westmeath Township conducted by Rev. Fred Dunning, Foresters Falls, assisted by Rev. A.A. Rigby, Pembroke and Rev. Eldon Craig, Shawville. Burial was in the Beachburg Union Cemetery. Pallbearers were Neil Thrasher, Carl Fletcher, J.W. Goudie, Abel Montgomery, Gordon Fletcher and Erwin Wilson. Soloist was Mrs. Lindsay Troke, Renfrew accompanied by Mrs. William Bennett.

Relatives and friends attended the funeral from Warren, Hawkesbury, Rutherglen, Ottawa, Pembroke, Renfrew, Greenwood and Cobden.
