N.B.—It is essential that taxpayers notify the Inspector of Taxation to whom this return is made of any subsequent change of address.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**—Fill in carefully the answers to the above questions and the particulars required on pages 2, 3 and 4 of this form. It is important to give all the information asked for, as otherwise the amount of the exemption and the tax assessable if any, cannot be determined by the assessing officer without further inquiry. In filling in proceeds of live stock sold during 1919 on page 2, the taxpayer is entitled to deduct the value as of 1st January, 1917, of any of these animals which he or she owned on that date.

**PENALTY:**—The Income War Tax Act, 1917, as amended, provides that every person required to make a return under Sub-Sec. 1 of Sec. 7 of the Act, who fails to make a return within the time limited therefor, shall be subject to a penalty of twenty-five per centum of the amount of the tax payable.

Any person, whether taxable or otherwise, who fails to make a return or provide information duly required according to the provisions of Sec. 8 of the Act, shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty of \$100 for each day during which the default continues. Also that any person making a false statement in any return or in any information required by the Minister, shall be liable, on summary conviction, to a penalty not exceeding \$10,000, or to six months imprisonment or to both fine and imprisonment.
