

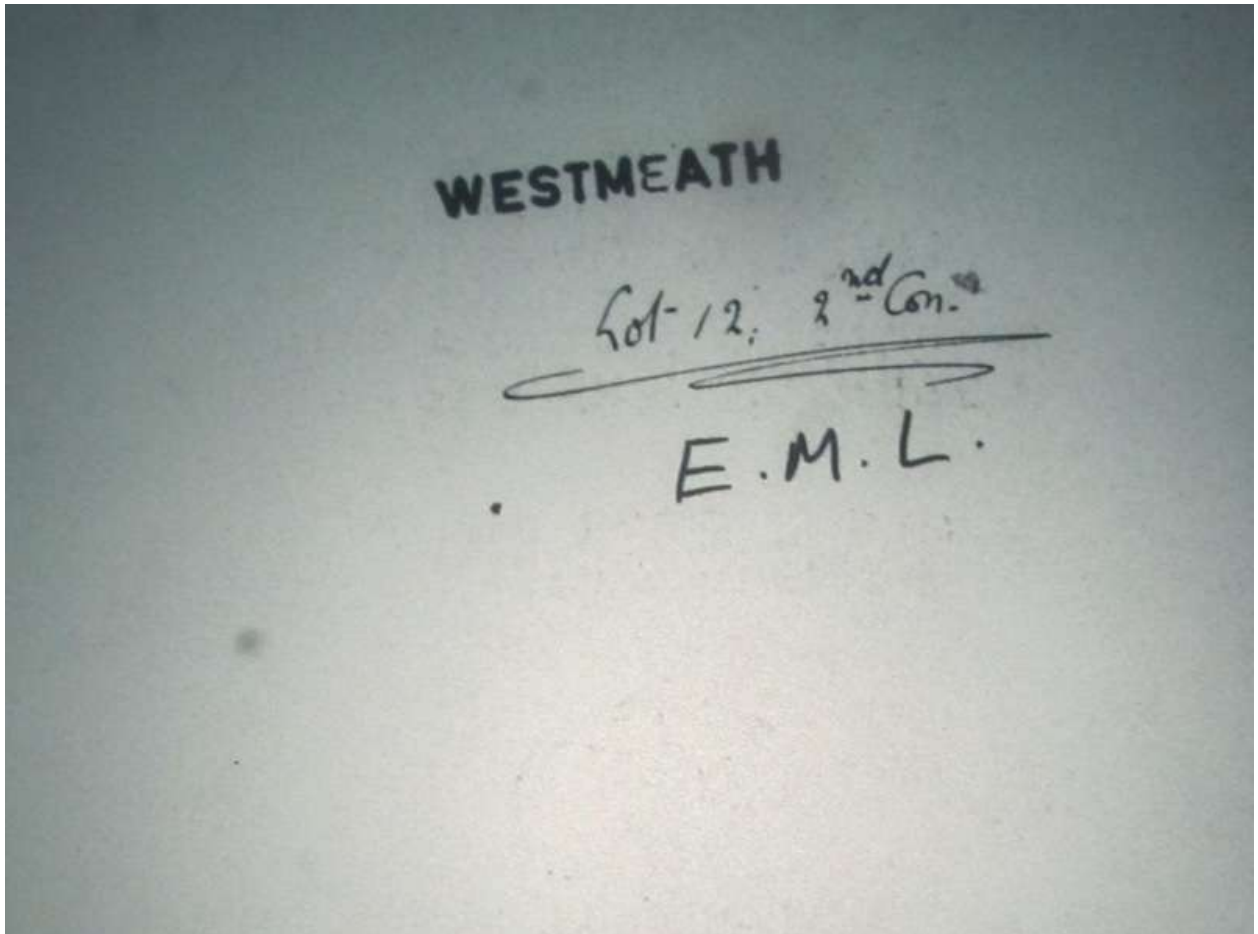

 Province aforesaid yeoman of the

 Senior for and in Consideration of ~~one~~ hundred
 Dollars of Lawful Money of the said Province to him
 in hand Paid by the said John Martin the
 Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath
 Granted, bargained, sold Remised, Released, and
 for Ever Granted, Claimed, and by these Presents
 doth Grant, bargain, sell, Remise, Release and
 for Ever quit Claim unto the said John Martin
 his heirs and assigns for Ever. All the Estate right
 title interest Claim Property and demand what
 soever, Either at Law or in Equity of him the said
 David Beack Senior if in to or out of all and singular
 that Certain Parcel or tract of Land and Remises situate
 lying and being in the Township of Westmount in the
 County of Renfrew aforesaid, which said Parcel of
 tract of Land and Remises may be otherwise known
 as follows that is to say, being composed of the north
 half of Lot number Twelve in the second Concession
 East of Muskrat Lake in the Township of Westmount
 aforesaid containing by actual measurement one
 hundred acres be the same more or less,
 Together with all houses, out-houses, woods and water
 thereon Erected lying and being and all and

party of the second part, to the said party of the first
part, the receipt whereof is hereby by him acknowledged
by the said party of the first part, Doth remise, release
and for ever quit claim unto the said party of the
second part, his heirs and assigns for ever.

All and singular, that certain parcel or tract
of Land and premises, situate, lying and being, comprised
and known as the East part of Lot number Twelve in
the second Concession of the Township of Westmeath
West of Muskrat Lake, in the County of Kenora,
said Lot of Land containing by admeasurement
One hundred Acres, be the same more or less.

Doth Have and Do Hold unto the said party

thereof from the Crown.
