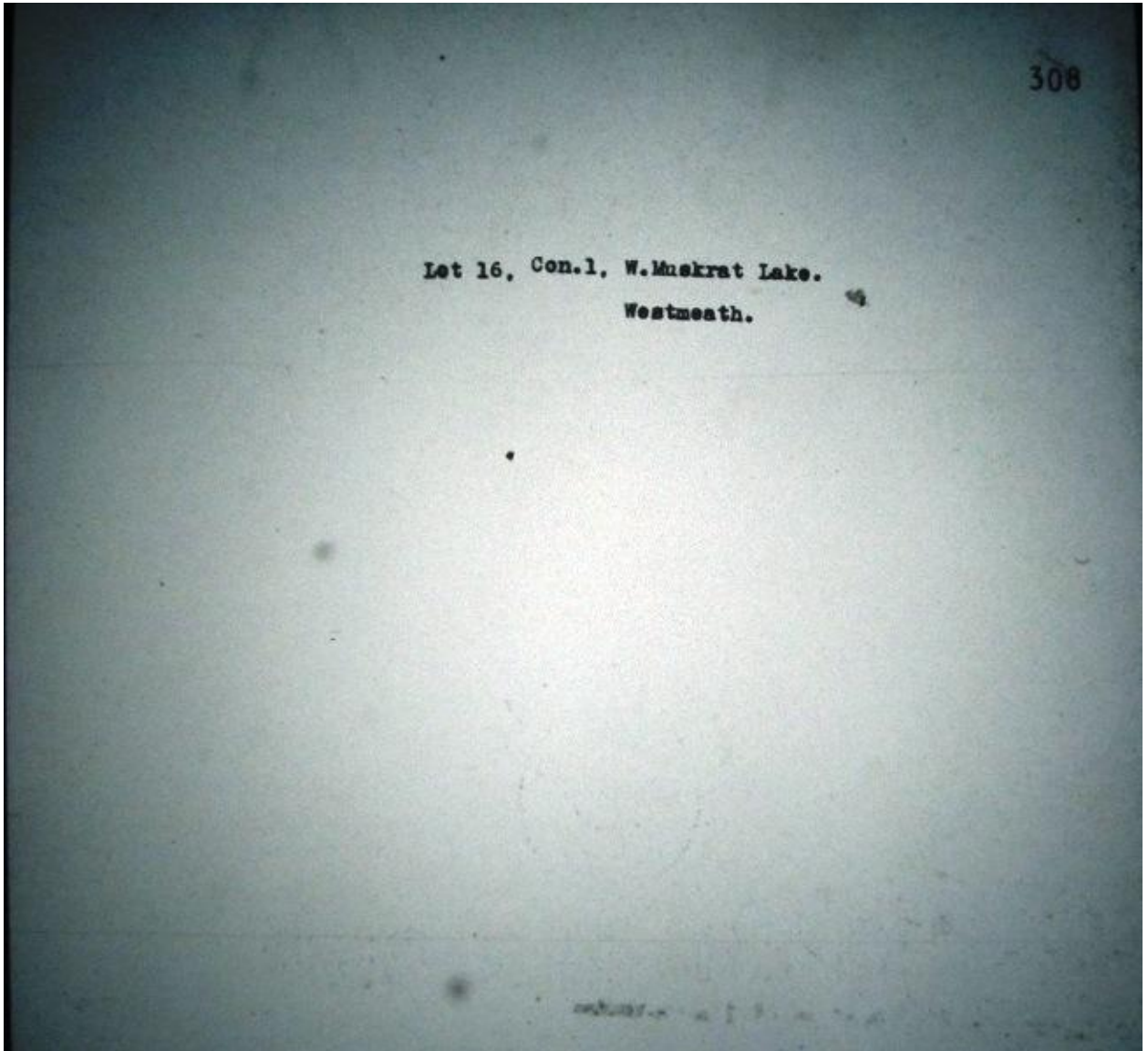

Ordered that John Kennedy, a native of Scotland, 28 years of age, born in the Parish of Kilmarnock, Inver-
nephire, a Soldier discharged at the Peace of Amiens from
the 7th Glasgow Fusible Regiment, now of Lot No. 14 in
the 1st Concession of the Indian Land in the Eastern
District, Western, shall receive a Grant of two hundred
acres of Land as a Soldier paying Full fees Regulation
27th December 1797, he being one of the chosen of the said
Regiment attested to in Lord Hobart's Letter of 1st March
1802.
