Sir

In answer to Your favour of the 29th ult. I beg
leave to state that in the Year 1752 I purchased a number
of U.C. Rights and among them was one from Pamela
Witter. The Petitions passed the Council and orders were
received by I M Staughton Esq. to locate and which were
located at my instance in this Township Pamela Witter's
right was located on Lot Number 17 in y^e t^h m^o and I
believe returns were made to the Sur. Gen^l's Office to that effect.
However last fall I received a Letter from Mr M Staughton
stating that my claim or rather that of Pamela Witter was
cancelled on account of this Miss Witter having sold
her right a second time and a location had been
made thereon in the upper part of the Province. now
as this Miss Witter is said to be a most ^{un}trustworthy person
in other respects than in this transaction I have no hope of
recovery from her I am nevertheless at a loss to discover
how I could have been deprived of my right as her former
Petition no doubt remains in the Executive Council Office and

has having been located upon that Petition. Thomas Ball Esq: of Toronto I believe was agent for the person who purchased the same right of this person and from whom I received a Letter early in the Year 1836 inquiring of me if I held a claim on one Thomas Wittet for Lands I immediately answered in reply that I had such a claim notwithstanding Mr Wittet having a knowledge of this fact I am informed that he obtained a Patent, as fraud is apparent in the transaction I feel that that justice will be done towards me - Israel Howland Wright is located on the front part of Lots number 29 and 30 in the north front A Concession - Elizabeth Wittet was located on Lot 21 1/2 Con and was part of Lot No 29 front E intended to have been north front A. This Lot I have transferred and have been subjected to great expense in procuring my Deeds Perhaps an error of E and A substituted might be made in such a manner as to prevent confusion and avoid considerable expense. The rear part of Lot 24 is entirely worthless being in a Tamarack swamp I regret that such a misunderstanding exists but I trust the information I have now given will shed such light upon the subject as will enable You to discover wherein the error lies. If You consider that I can
