In great haste I have requested that  
 Alexander Mill be the bearer of  
 this letter to the Council of Regency and  
 provided of Canada, that to Mr. M. G. G.  
 and in consideration of the sum of  
 1000 pounds of lawful money of Canada  
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 by the said Council of Regency and  
 the said Mr. M. G. G. and for a quiet  
 claim unto John the father of the township  
 of Drummond in the County of Lanark and  
 Province aforesaid, upon an full my  
 right title interest property and demand  
 relating unto the same of in to and out  
 of all and sundry that certain parcel of  
 land and meadows situated lying  
 and being in the County of Lanark  
 in the County of Lanark and Province  
 of Canada, which may be known as  
 follows: that is to say the north west  
 quarter of the Township of the South  
 West of the County of Lanark  
 aforesaid containing in all an acre and  
 fifty acres be the same more or less.  
 In testimony whereof I have hereunto set  
 my hand and affixed my seal this 20th day  
 of October 1861.
