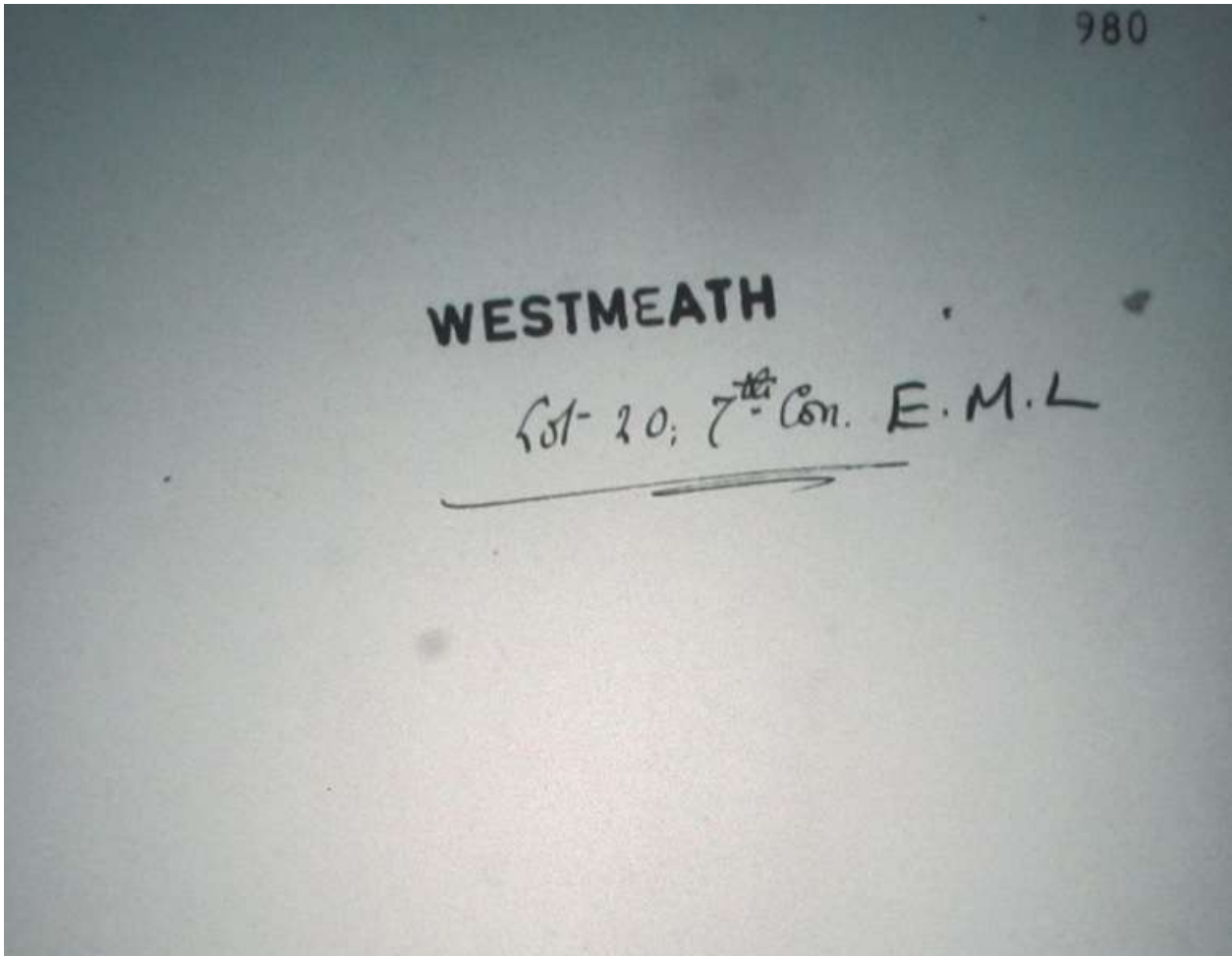

 more or less, to the limit between the *7th and 8th* Concessions
 then North *2 1/4* degrees *West* minutes *East* *30* chains *68* Links
 more or less, to the *allowance for Road* limit between Lots No. *20* and *21*
 then South *5 1/4* degrees *25* minutes *East* *66* chains *67* Links
 more or less, to the *allowance for Road* between the *6th and 7th* Concessions
 then South *2 1/4* degrees *East* minutes *West* *30* chains *68* Links
 more or less, to the place of beginning

containing *200* Acres more or less.
