ni Bromley, has desired me respectfully to request,
that, you will have the kindness to inform her,
to whom the Patent Deed from the Crown issued,
for Lot No. four in the second Concession, fronting
on Coulouge Lake, in the Township of Westmeath
in the County of Renfrew.

In explanation of the above, I beg leave
to state, that Mrs. Brownlee, along with her
family have been living upon the said Lot since
its purchase - that the Documents conveying
the Land to her, have by some means disappeared,

getting the name of the person to whom the
Patent was issued, she may be enabled to apply
