Pursuant to the request of  
 Mr. Hugh Chamberlain, I have the honor to submit to you,  
 the report of inspection and valuation of Lot number 10, in  
 Commission B, Part 1st E, in the Township of Westmount, a Clay  
 soil which will require thorough subsoil draining to fit it for  
 successful culture, the timber is Spruce and Balsam fir, White Pine,  
 Alder &c. The East half is a Clay subsoil, supporting a sandy  
 clay loam, dotted with White Pine, Maple and Balsam fir, the  
 present value of this Lot does not exceed Four Shillings and  
 nine pence per acre.

The only improvement in the above Lot  
 is about two acres of clearing, in conjunction with the improvement  
 in the adjoining Lot No 12.
